2. CAREER DEVELOPMENT PLAN

Summarize plans for career development.

Summary of the candidate and career goals; composition and credential of the candidate's Thesis committee.

Who will be the field instructor(s) for the Practicum? Who will be the advisor for the research thesis?

3. PLANS FOR PRACTICUM/Research Thesis

Describe the anticipated practicum activities and the research question or project for the master's Thesis (preferred). If approved for funding, masters scholars will be allowed to submit practicum proposal/ research proposal before second semester or sometime before year 2.

4. COMPLIANCE (Required for any grants dealing with human or animal subjects)

5. LIST OF RECOMMENDERS: List the name, title, and email address of two persons, other than your proposed mentor(s), who can critically appraise your qualifications. They should be able to comment on your character, motivation, maturity, general knowledge, ability to use research techniques, originality, specialized experience, and training. Attach two letters of recommendation. (no page limits)
